AWARD FOR ODISSEA

ODISSEA 2000, the Italian waterpark which this year became home to the first installation of Polin's Windigo attraction, has subsequently won an award for it.

The massive slides, called Chimera by the Rossano Calabria-based park, helped Odissea win the best Italian waterpark for 2008 in the national Parksmania awards. The ride starts with enclosed aquatube slides and transforms into high-speed multi-racer lanes.

As well as the Windigo, Polin has another waterslide installed at the park which, it claims, is the longest of its kind in Europe. The 300m long slide was installed in 2004 and is a combination of big rafting slide and big hole slide, both with a diameter of 2,000mm.

Polin has also recently completed installations at the new 25,000sq.m Djubga Aquapark in Russia.
