GOLDEN BAY AQUAPARK

The water park Buhtagold, which in the English language is named Golden Bay Aqua Park (because it's nestled in a bay area of the Black Sea Coastline), was significantly extended for the 2009 season, so much so that it can now use the title "Largest Water Park in Russia".

The park occupies a ground area of 152,000 m² and now has 44 water slides, all of which were manufactured by the Turkish firm Polin. In the peak season, up to 4,000 guests attend the park daily.

The Golden Bay Water Park is located directly on the Black Sea coast near the city of Gelendzhik in Krasnodar Krai. There are two other smaller water parks there, as well as in particular the theme park Admiral Vrungel, which continues as before to be used by the manufacturer Pax as a showcase. A new airport is also being currently built, as the health resort Gelendzhik has 40,000 beds available, and is visited by quite a number of tourists annually. ■
