India Welcomes First King Cobra Water Slide

An aerial view of the King Cobra water slide in the Amaazia Amusement Park in the port city of Surat, on the west coast of India, reveals two double tubes racing through a series of spirals before dropping eight meters into the “Valley of the Cobra.” Riders reach speeds of more than 30 mph. Theming is built into the fiberglass design. The 2-hectare, US\$26 million water park

is the first phase of a larger attraction—owned by the Rajgreen Group and being developed by Sanderson. The completed complex is expected to include an indoor amusement park, 7-D theater, bird park, snow park, and more.
